 Re: Recent polling in Florida's 20th Congressional District
 Date: October 28, 2021

The results of our recent poll of likely Democratic primary election voters in Florida's 20th Congressional District¹ show that Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick, Dale Holness, and Barbara Sharief are strong candidates and are within striking distance of winning a race that is likely to be decided by a low margin given the number of candidates in the field.

McCormick, Holness, and Sharief are Top Candidates in 11-Way Primary

Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick (15%), Dale Holness (14%), and Barbara Sharief (13%) are all competitive candidates for the upcoming primary election. Candidates like Bobby DuBose (6%), Omari Hardy (5%), Phil Jackson (2%), and Priscilla Ann Taylor (2%) are all polling in single digits and would need to significantly change the dynamics of the race to have a shot at winning next Tuesday.

¹ Expedition Strategies conducted 500 total interviews in FL-20 with a sample of likely Democratic primary voters. The interviews were conducted October 20-24, 2021. The margin of error for overall results is ±4.38% and higher among subgroups.
