

Motion to Instruct Conferees

Mr. LANKFORD moves that the managers on the part of the Senate at the conference on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses on the Senate amendment to the bill H.R. 4521 be instructed to insist that the final conference report include provisions requiring that any agreement negotiated by the United States with the Islamic Republic of Iran addressing Iran's development of nuclear weapons—

1 (1) also includes provisions addressing the full
2 range of Iran's destabilizing activities, including de-
3 velopment of the means of delivery for such weapons
4 (such as ballistic missiles), support for terrorism,
5 and evasion of sanctions by individuals, entities, and
6 vessels in the trade of petroleum products with the
7 People's Republic of China;

8 (2) does not lift sanctions on the Islamic Revo-
9 lutionary Guard Corps; and

10 (3) does not revoke the designation of the Is-
11 lamic Revolutionary Guard Corps as a foreign ter-
12 rorist organization under section 219 of the Immi-
13 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189).
